REPORT OF THE SECRETARY: The December minutes were accepted.

REPORT OF THE TREASURER: Filed for audit. Discuss moving temporary restricted assets to income and expense statement in January for February meeting.

LIBRARY DIRECTOR'S REPORT: Circulation computer is in place. Preservation project is in the works.

FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY REPORT: Peter Pinkham is to speak on February 11 about his newest book. Books to be sold at the summer book sale are starting to accumulate. The annual meeting will be held in April. There will be a seminar on fiddling contests on April 29.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: The trustees declined to decrease the operating budget at the Selectmen's meeting on January 12. Capital improvement proposal was to be \$12,800 for the handicap ramp replacement. It was deferred and will be revisited in future years.
