## Madison Library Nook/Kindle eReader Borrowing Policy and Agreement

A Nook or Kindle can be checked out by a Madison Library member who is 14 years of age or older and in good standing (i.e., no overdues). By checking out a Madison Library eReader, the member agrees to the following:

- The eReader can be checked out for two weeks and should be handed directly to a librarian when returned. Do not place the eReader in the library's book drop or leave at the desk if unattended. If the eReader is returned in the drop slot, a \$5 fee will be charged. If eReader is damaged in the book drop, full replacement cost plus \$25 will be charged.
- 2. Please return all parts of the device in the case provided, including the cable, wall outlet adapter, protective cover (if equipped with one), and instruction manual. Borrower will be charged for missing or damaged items when eReader is returned.
- If the eReader is not returned or is damaged, borrower will be charged replacement cost plus \$25.
- 4. The Library will not purchase titles for eReaders.
- All eBooks must be transferred to the eReader at the library, on the designated computers. Patrons are encouraged to borrow eBooks from the New Hampshire Downloadable Books Consortium using their own library card. Patrons may also download free eBooks to the eReaders.
- 6. Library staff will assist borrowers in downloading titles to the eReader. Borrowers are encouraged to set up an appointment with the librarian the first time they plan to borrow the eReader.
- 7. Please do not register the Nook at Barnes & Noble or the Kindle at Amazon with a personal credit card or purchase items for the eReader.
- 8. Please do not let anyone else borrow the eReader or allow young children to play with the device.
- 9. Please treat the device well and keep it safe from water and from being dropped or crushed.
- 10. Have fun learning about the Nook or Kindle and eBooks!
